

Dr. Joachim Florian Fritz was born on 30 October 1975 in Salzburg. He studied law as well as Spanish, Portuguese and French at the universities of Salzburg and Salamanca from 1994 to 1998. He completed his doctorate in 2000 with a dissertation on the subject of crime victim protection under both Spanish and Austrian legal systems.
